After several hours' deliberation, the jury in the suit of the Pennsylvania Salt Manufacturing Company against the city to recover approximately \$200,000 damages for injury to its property at Weccaco avenue and Shunk street, returned a verdict of but \$12,500 in favor of the claimant. This amount of damages were practically the figures of the city experts, who admitted that it would cost the company between \$11,000 and \$12,000 to adjust its buildings to the revised lines of grade.

The case came before Judge Barratt of Common Pleas Court No. 2 on an appeal from the findings of a road jury, which rejected a claim on account of legal procedure, but released a provision trial the company succeeded in getting an award in Common Pleas Court No. 2 of \$75,000.
